

Parts Cleaner/Assembler/Painter

Job Summary

To clean, assemble, prepare for painting, paint and package finished parts for shipment according to work order specifications and company policies.

Responsibilities

- Cleans parts using various hand and powered hand tools to remove metal slag or finish surface debris, ensuring parts are cleaned to work order specifications.
- Washes parts using a wash booth or chemical solvents to remove all debris in preparation for painting.
- Wet paints parts to work order specifications.
- Performs assembly work as required for finished product according to work order specifications. Performs accurate fitting and adjusting to required tolerances as specified.
- Packages final assembled parts for shipment according to work order specifications.
- Repeatedly inspects work to ensure quality of product.
- Records accurate labor records.
- Maintains a clean work area.
- Performs all work maintaining quality standards.
- Performs all work in a safe manner by wearing proper PPE for each job and adhering to safety regulations and standards.
- Performs other duties as required.
